The Minutes

1. Introduction

The president Flavien Aubelle is busy, replaced by the secretary Lorenz Trippel

2. Approval of minutes of meeting held 17th of May 2012

The last year's minutes have been approved.

4. Report of 2012 Accounting

Lorenz gives a short report, Expenses and Income are almost equal. The Swiss Go Federation manages the Yunguseng foundation which got a plus of 1100 Fr this year.

6. Activity report: Committee

- Flavien and Lorenz have written a Booklet to present the Swissgo Assoc. to sponsors. Flavien is taking some management classes at EPFL where he gets ideas and help / networking to find sponsors.
- Possible cooperation with Ishi Cup and Orc'ldée.
- Lorenz organized two go camps one in April and an second one in December both in Montbonvon with each had around 15 participants.
- Little overview over tournaments and clubs: Bern still no tournament. Basel (Norman moved away, Casia and Cuba moved in). LcdF active Club, they had a stand at the Ludesco fair, will organize a tournament 14-15 september. Sandra, Roberto and Dominik reported the situation in their Club. Rick reports that Lausanne Club and TDP merged.

7. Activity report: Teaching

Flavien, Lorenz, Armel are / have been participating in the Yunguseng Dojang.

There are around 50 players and 15 spectators participating of which 16 are swiss, the number of swiss participants has been very stable throughout the 6 season played so far.

Seokbin and In-seong have given courses and joined tournaments as teacher.

In-seong will start a teach the teachers program in Germany / France.

8. Activity report: European Go Federation

Lorenz reports about the situation and future of the EGF / IGF.

There is a sponsor from China (Bejing) who wants to help establish a pro system for european players and a european cup will be part of that system to give some competition between the new pros and make these cup tournaments much more attractive.

9. Activity report: European Team Championship

Félicien Mazille was the captain for the recent season. The Swiss Team only reached 8th place and has to play the relegation game 28th of May against Slovenia. Felicien will stop being captain for the next season. He suggests somebody who has not to play should take over his position.

10. Journée suisse du go (François)

11. Salaire des joueurs professionnels (Sandra)

Les clubs invitent régulièrement des joueurs forts tels In-Seong Hwang ou Seokbin Cho pour des cours ou analyser les parties jouées lors des tournois. Ces professionnels étant rémunérés, il serait juste de fixer un salaire au niveau suisse. Cela permettrait d'avoir une base pour l'organisation et proposer à chacun le même tarif.

12. Swiss Team Championship (Armel-David)

The swiss team championship goal is a championship between swiss clubs.

The games will be played on KGS. The invitations to the club will send out in June 2013, each club can register 1 or more team of 3 players, smaller club can also play with other players the only condition is that they are swiss residents or have a swiss passport. There will be 1 game per month.

It was decided that the board of the Swiss Go Federation supports Marcel's project fully and with all available resources!

Lorenz will try to buy 200 pieces, if they are cheaper than 2 € possibly more.

15. 2 tournois minimum pour les points du championnat suisse (Séb, Benoît)

These rules will be changed, added:

- Foreign tournaments are accepted but 1 tournament should still be still in Switzerland, so it's ok to have 1 tournament outside.
- Yunguseng participation as a player counts like 1 tournament participation
- European / Swiss Team Championship participation over the internet counts as 1 tournament participation (real life encounters count as normal tournament)

- The Championship should be earlier than May because there are many exams around May.
- o It should be open to all players also foreigners and kyu players.

This proposition was accepted with 8 in favour, 7 against.
